

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

MEDICAL FORM 2

It is the aim of the school staff to take as many pupils as possible on any school camp, trip or excursion within the realms of personal and group safety. The first concern is for the safety and well-being of your child. Consideration also has to be given to the overall smooth operation of the camp or continuation of the trip for the pupils and their teachers.

1. It is a condition of the trip that:

In the event of your child needing to be withdrawn for any reason as determined by the teachers-in-charge and Principal, or a medical practitioner, including illness or injury, it is the responsibility of the parent to:

- (a) Pay to transport (including Ambulance or air fare) their child home
- (b) Pay for the transportation of a supervisor (if required)
- (c) Come and collect their child if this is the agreed course of action
- (d) Accept liability for doctor and / or hospitalisation should this be required
- (e) Make any other appropriate arrangement

- 2. Regarding bedwetting. Please discuss individual cases with the teachers on how to handle the clothes and bedding situation.
- 3. In the event of your child requiring medication that commences just prior to the trip and not set out on these forms, please inform the teacher in charge, in writing, of the details, prior to the trip. Please place medication in a sealed, named bag, including dosage instructions and hand to the teacher in charge prior to the trip.
- 4. We trust that should any child develop symptoms of colds or influenza (temperature, profuse runny nose, severe cough, sore throat etc) in the days leading up to our departure, that this child be withdrawn from the trip. With everyone "living" in such close proximity the potential to infect large numbers of people is great.
